The Venetia Heritage Society (VHS) invites you to join its 2025 Fundraising Campaign. It is one of the oldest 20th Century structures in Peters Township.

It is home to several non-profit groups such as the PT Girl Scouts, The DARE/Montour Model RR Club, the Area Council on Aging, and a local 4H group.

The VHS has identified key goals as part of its Strategic Planning process. These include: Repair and make renovations to the interior and exterior of the building, determine ways in which some rooms can be repurposed, improve the financial stability of the organization, and raise the visibility of the Venetia Community Center in our community.

Participation in the Village of Venetia's Light Up Night has benefitted the VHS through donations. Our sponsored Montour Model RR Club is receiving area-wide recognition. The all-volunteer VHS Executive Board is preparing for a 100th Anniversary Celebration in 2026 and the VHS is a member of the Peters Township Chamber of Commerce.
